Joanne Dugan is a visual artist who lives and works in New York City. Her work is represented at the [Marlborough Gallery](#) in New York City and the [Kopeikin Gallery](#) in Los Angeles.

Her work involves the in-depth use of photographic materials and process to explore and create visual renderings of time, space and various states of human consciousness. Currently informed by the slowness and limitations of traditional (and quickly disappearing) light-based analog photo materials, she creates small and unique-image limited editions of handmade works that utilize hand-cutting techniques, chemical alterations, vintage materials and repetition. The darkroom is a key component in her process, as she explores and pays homage to the physical limitations and opportunities found in analog methods, while also seeking to reinterpret their potential for mindfulness-based creation in a digital age.
