Joanne Dugan is a visual artist who lives and works in New York City. Her current practice involves the experimental use of traditional silver-based analog materials and technology to explore photography as a three-dimensional, physical medium. Her unique-image works utilize intricate, repetitive hand-cutting and painting techniques, chemical alterations and vintage equipment to pay homage to the physical limitations and opportunities found in analog methods, while also exploring the potential for creating works informed by mindfulness practices. Each piece is fully rendered by hand, slowly. Her work is represented at the Marlborough Gallery in New York City and the Kopeikin Gallery in Los Angeles.
